Playdough Recipe

Children love to play with play dough and it is great for developing fine motor skills. Please find below our recipe, we often add fragrances, food colouring or glitter to the recipe.

1 cup of plain flour

1tbsp oil

1 cup water

½ cup of salt

2 tbsp. cream of Tartar

Food Colouring

Mix all dry ingredients together in a large bowl

Add all wet ingredients to a jug and gradually add to the bowl of dry ingredients, stir to remove all lumps.

Cook in the microwave for 2 minutes, stir and cook again, repeat this process until playdough is firm and not sticky. More flour may need to be added.


Allow to cool before children are able to play with it. At this point Glitter can be added and kneaded in by the children.


