### Silver Street Site

We would like to take this opportunity to remind our parents and carers of our 'drop off' procedure in the mornings.

The school gates in Wharf Lane open at 8.40am. Please could parents/ carers walk their children across the school playground to Apple Orchard Pre-school, place their children's lunch boxes in the black trolley and wait along the ramp. We will open the doors at 8.45am, you can leave the children at the door, where we will help the children hang their coats and bags on their pegs ready for their day of adventures. Please can we ask that you do not take older siblings to their class or go to the school office. School children must follow the procedure that the school already have in place. The school gates will then be closed at 8.50 am


