Parking - Wharf Lane

We are again seeing significant issues with cars parked contravening the parking restrictions at school pick up and drop off on Wharf Lane. Whilst those with relevant disabled parking badges can park in the area other vehicles should not be parking/dropping off on the zig zags or single yellow lines or turning around in neighbours' drive ways.

Families have raised concerns about the safety aspects of this for both the children and adults dropping off and picking up.

We have informed the Civil Enforcement Officers (Traffic Wardens) and they will be increasing their patrols around the area at this time.

Holiday requests need to be completed on the Local Authority agreed forms which are available from the office. Please request these at least 3 school weeks in advance of any planned departure. Term time leave will only be agreed in exceptional circumstances and if the reason is due to work commitments, your employer will need to submit a letter explaining why you cannot have a week's holiday in any of the six school holidays across the year. Where holidays are requested based on previous Covid cancellation we will need evidence in writing of when the holiday was cancelled and the subsequent offer that couldn't be in the school holidays.

If any of our families have any, socks, shoes or wellies spare we would be very grateful for them to add to our store of spare clothes for the children.




Scooters and Bikes – Ditton Street Pre School
