Arriving at school on time

Recently, we have noticed an increase in the number of children arriving late for school. As a reminder, our times are:

Silver Street campus – children should be in class by 8.50am with gates opening from 8.40am

Ditton Street campus – children should be in class by 9.00am with gates opening from 8.50am

We appreciate there may be random times when unforseeable things happen making families late but this should not be a regular occurrence. Arriving late can be make it difficult for the children to settle into the school day and they can also have missed learning input as lessons start promptly after the bell and registration. If you are having difficulties getting your child to school please come and talk to us as we will try and help to signpost you to support and resources.
