Transition sessions for September School starters

Transition sessions for the preschool leavers are being held on Monday 19th, Tuesday 20th and Wednesday 21st June – 9.30am -10.30am. Should your child be in session at Apple Orchard then you are welcome to collect your child and drop off after your visit to their class.


