### **Transition Day**

This week all our children in years R to Y5 enjoyed visiting their new class and teacher ready for September. The morning was filled with lots of activities to get to know each other and even a start on making things the children would like up on the displays when the new term starts.

We have our next transition day on Wednesday where all children will be in their new classes and the majority will have their new teacher (subject to NEU Industrial Action). This will again give them a chance to settle into their new class and for groups like Year 2, to spend more time on the Ditton St campus.

Children should arrive as normal on Wednesday to be registered in their current classes and they will then be taken to their new class.

After school, families will be able to come and visit both sites and see the classroom and in most cases meet the teaching staff informally from the end of the school day to 4.05pm at Silver St and 4.15pm at Ditton St.



### **Weather**

Please can we ask that children come to school equipped for the weather. Many sun creams last 8 hours so can be put on before school. Children can bring their own but will need to put this on themselves, although classroom staff will give reminders before lunchtime. 15 hours per week for two years olds

30 hours per week for 3 to 4 year olds - for working parents.
