## **Gates in September**

Due to the access to Silver Street via Wharf Lane being closed until the 12<sup>th</sup> September by National Grid, we are going to open the gate by Wharf Lane car park as well as the double gates on the 6<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup> September, as we are aware more children may be accessing this way. From the 12<sup>th</sup> September it will just be the double gates and front gate.

We would also like to ask that for September 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> that your children enter school via the double gates or back gate on Wharf Lane. This is because our Reception children will be using the front gate (opposite the church). We would like to keep these first few days as quiet as possible while they get used to coming into school and finding their classrooms. If you have a Reception child and they have a sibling they are welcome to come into school with your Reception (via the gate opposite the church).
