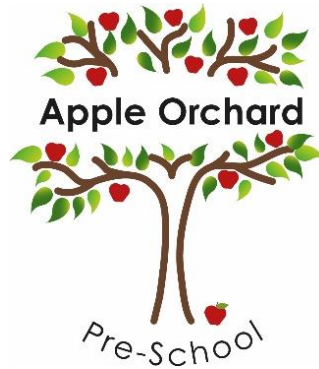

Pre-School and Illnesses

Important Reminder: If your child is feeling generally unwell with a cold, sore throat etc. please think carefully about whether they are well enough to fully enjoy playing in our busy and active preschool. Administering Calpol to a poorly child only masks symptoms for a short period of time and they are likely to pass on their illness to others. Children need time to rest when they are unwell, so please do not bring them back too soon. Children need to be kept at home for 48 hours after the last incidence of vomiting or diarrhoea. Thank you for your support with this.



2 year old funding

Starting from April 2024, eligible working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours free childcare. If you qualify you will need to visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to apply. If you are entitled you will be given a code. Please speak to Helen at the pre-school as a consent form for your details will need to be completed.
