Shoeboxes

We will again be working with The Minster to support Blythswood Care and their shoebox scheme which this year will see their filled shoeboxes delivered to Ukraine. Parking at the Royal Oak, Ditton Street

We've received a concern from The Royal Oak on Ditton St about families parking on their property to drop off and collect children and the impact this is having on their business. Please can we remind families that this is not parking for the school and that their parking and grounds must not be used for this purpose. We want to maintain good links with the community and ask that families support this by parking in legal and considerate ways when dropping and collecting from school. Playdough recipe

Here is the recipe for making your own playdough – we would love to know what colours and smells who have created.

- 2 cups plain flour (all purpose)
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil (baby oil and coconut oil work too)
- 1/2 cup <u>salt</u>
- 2 tablespoons <u>cream of tartar</u>
- 1 to 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right)
- <u>gel food colouring</u> (optional)
- few drops <u>glycerine</u> (my secret ingredient for stretch and shine!)

Method:

- Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl
- Add food colouring TO the boiling water then into the dry ingredients
- Stir continuously until it becomes a sticky, combined dough
- Add the glycerine (optional)
- Allow it to cool down then take it out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all of the stickiness has gone. * This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency!*
- If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right



Sessions

We have spaces available across both of our sites. Please let us know if you or anyone else you know may need care for children aged between 2-4 years.

We also have the flexibility to offer breakfast and after school club should you need it.
